
3.1. Main Body

3.1.1 Handling by Package

(1) Main Body Packaging Box


■ Lifting positions on the front and rear sides and prohibited parts






Insert the forklift forks from the front and back of the pallet and place the forklift forks securely in the lifting position.

Insert the forklift forks all the way in.




(Example)



The tip of the forklift forks should come out. Insert the forklift forks all the way in so that there is no gap between the forklift and the box, and the entire pallet is fully on the forks.



Short forklift forks can damage the pallet. Do not lift the pallet with only half the forklift forks inserted.



(2) Main Body


■ Lifting position and prohibited parts




Caution

3.1.2 Devanning

Use a forklift to remove it from the container.



Use a forklift that meets the following conditions.

- · Maximum load: 1.5t or more
- · Allowable load: About 1.5t or more
- Forklift forks thickness should be within 185 mm

Lift with the center of gravity mark position as the center.

Insert the forklift forks all the way in.





Caution

Do not lift anywhere other than the lifting position.

Load is applied to an inappropriate place, the device will be damaged.

Insert from long side







Lift claw length2.5m or more

The tip of the forklift forks should come out. Insert the forklift forks all the way in so that there is no gap between the forklift and the box, and the entire pallet is fully on the forks.




Short forklift forks can damage the pallet. Do not lift the pallet with only half the forklift forks inserted.

3.2. Remove from Pallet

Be sure to perform unpacking work in the presence of a service engineer. Before removing it from the pallet, it is necessary to remove the fixture.


Use a forklift or the included slope to unload the body from the pallet.
