


20 STEPS A Day Costs You \$50,000 A Year

Since then, there has been a significant change in this thinking across many companies.


This document unpacks the reasons why businesses are now enjoying a decentralised print and copy solution.

Be More Productive

Do the maths on a person taking 20 steps or more to a central copier, and you'll find a black hole in your office productivity.

A 20 step round-trip to a central copier will waste at least one minute per print job, with plenty of distractions as [this recent study](#) suggests.

Rely On More Uptime

Decentralising your copier with a blended solution of copiers and desktop devices not only gives you productivity benefits, but offers built-in redundancy.

If your centralised copier runs out of toner, is being used for a large print job, or is not working, you still have your local desktop device at arm's length.

This not only decentralises your printing so you can rely on more uptime, but also de-stresses your staff.



Enjoy Privacy & Security

Centralised copiers have security features like PIN codes or card authentication to protect against important or sensitive documents being left on the copier.
