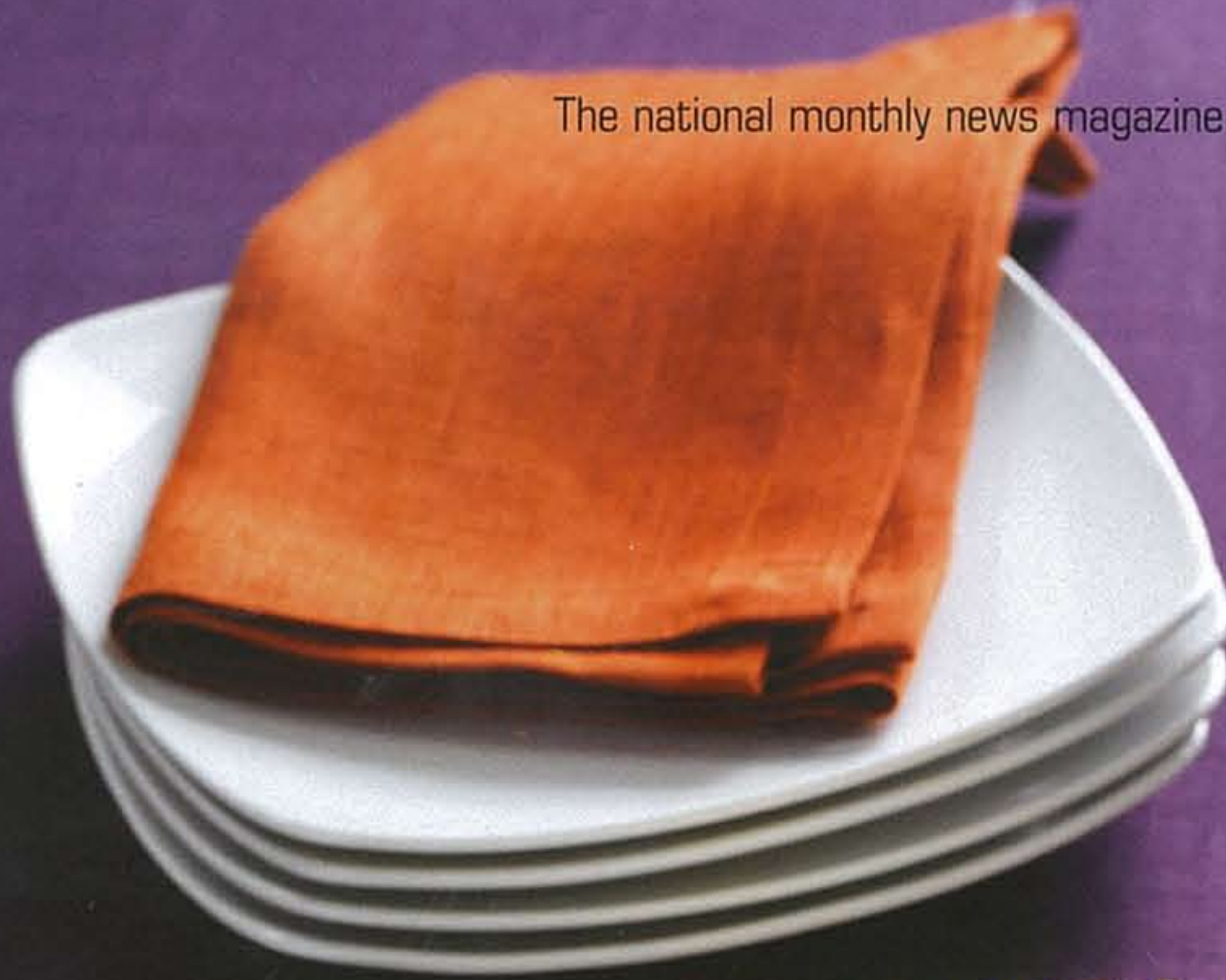

Varietal Extra Virgin Olive Oils have just been released.

Bottled as three single varieties, Frantoio, New Norcia and Leccino, Chapman Hill olives are picked and pressed locally, within hours of leaving the branches, ensuring the freshest possible product is delivered to the customer.

All three varieties are labelled with the year of harvest (similar to wines), and have distinctly different flavours. While the Frantoio (a traditional Tuscan variety) has strong grassy undertones, the Leccino (also from Tuscany) has a peppery kick and the New Norcia (a variety that evolved naturally in a Western Australia monastery of the same name over a century ago) has an interesting nutty character. All three oils are certified by the Australian Olive Association.

Porridge in 90 seconds

Gourmet muesli producer Carman's has added 90 second Honey Roasted Nut and Fruit & Seed Porridge Sachets to its foodservice offering.



Carman's Honey Roasted Nut and Fruit & Seed Porridge Sachets are made up of 100 per cent Australian oats, ground to a finer consistency than usual so they cook quicker than traditional oats. The sachets contain a natural mix of ground oats, nuts, fruit and seeds, including black chia seeds, which have been hailed as a superfood.

The 90 second sachets join Carman's 40g portion control sachets and bulk bags of Original (Fruit-Free), Classic Fruit and Natural Bircher (Untoasted) variants. Carman's also makes a gluten-free fruit muesli, Deluxe, which is available in both 35g portions and 1.2kg bulk bags. Carman's products are free from artificial colours, flavours and preservatives, as well as being free

of genetically modified ingredients, and Kosher and Halal accredited.

Blitz fruit flies fast

Just in time for fly season Insect-o-matic has introduced the Nectar unit, designed to discreetly offer protection against fungal gnats (commonly called fruit flies) and other flying pests in foodservice businesses such as bars, restaurants, cafes, salad bars and wineries.

"Fungal gnats are a major pest problem in the warmer months," said Paul Hope, general manager of Insect-o-matic. "They are attracted to drinks such as wine, cordial, mixer drinks and beer as well as fruit. Until now there has not been a product on the market specifically targeting fungal gnats."

The Nectar unit uses melon scented glueboards, a patented Synergetic UVA-Green light and trays containing a liquid attractant (such as wine or vinegar) to effectively attract the insects. Even better, the stainless steel construction and discreet design mean that customers won't know that the unit is an insect control product, making it suitable for highly visible areas such as bars, open plan kitchens and serving areas.
